



1. EDUCATION AND COMMUNICATION

- Parents will be advised, before lessons start, of the expected conduct for themselves and their children.
- Signage posted indicating sign in and out procedures, traffic patterns, and health screening protocols.
- Training for staff regarding prevention, cleaning/sanitizing, and maintaining distancing while teaching.



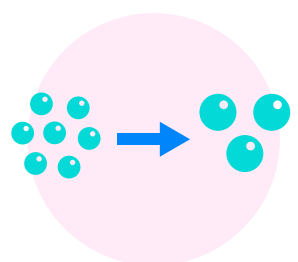
2. HEALTH CHECKS

- Pre-session health screen reminder will be emailed to parents. Children with any symptoms of illness should not come to class and will be offered a full refund.
- Daily health check screening for all instructors and swimmers including verbal confirmation of travel history, health status, visual check, and temperature check.
- Anyone who exhibits health concerns at camp will be immediately isolated for evaluation and sent home.



3. SOCIAL DISTANCING / PPE

- Health check drop off and pick up lines with designated ground markings six feet apart.
- One parent per child will be allowed for drop off and pick up, parents will be required to leave the area during lesson times and no non-essential visitors allowed.
- Plexiglass divider to serve as a safe barrier between face to face interaction at check in and pick up.
- Instruction time will be 50 minutes in length to facilitate physical distancing at pick up.
- Each class will meet by a large numbered cone with participants sitting in individual hula hoops spaced apart for drop off and pick up.
- There will be no access to the change rooms or showers (toilets will remain open). Swimmers are required to arrive dressed and ready to swim. At the end of class, instructors will help swimmers with their towels or robes and gather their belongings at the end of class for pick up.
- Instructors will all be issued face shields and will be required to use them in the pool and when social distancing cannot be maintained (and/or other health authority recommendations and guidelines).
- Administrative staff and instructors not in the water will be issued face masks.



4. REDUCED NUMBER OF CLASSES AND SMALL CLASS "BUBBLES"

- Pedalheads pool capacity and number of classes will be restricted to a limit where physical distancing can be safely practiced. The limit will vary between pools depending on the size of the pool and deck area.
- It is anticipated that initially, participant levels will be limited to approximately 1/3 of our normal capacity.
- Individual classes will remain small (maximum 4 children per instructor and 3 children per instructor for beginner levels) and will stay together for the duration of the session.
- Classes will not intermingle and wherever possible instructors will not change.
- Lane ropes and tot docks will keep classes separated and swimmers apart.



5. CLEANING AND SANITIZATION

- Hand sanitizer will be sprayed on hands of all staff and swimmers prior to entering the facility and will be available for all swimmers to use at pick up.
- Each swimmer will be given their own basket of pool supplies (toys, pool rings, kickboard, etc.). All items and pool equipment will be disinfected at the end of each class. Toys will not be shared.
- Routine cleaning and disinfecting of high touch surfaces and thorough environmental cleaning daily.
